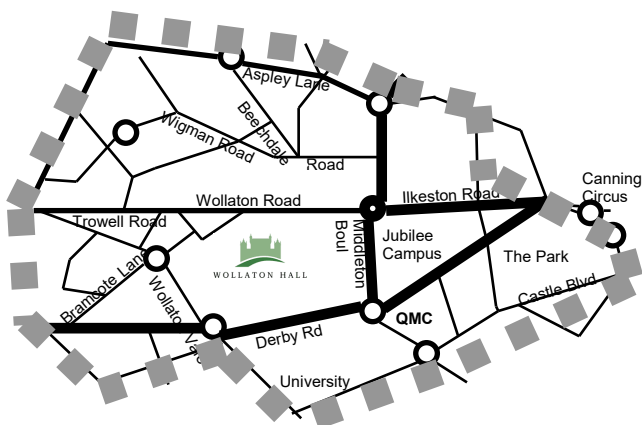

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

We CAN NOT take prescription request over the phone, please make requests for repeat prescriptions in writing to the reception desk or online via our website. These can be collected 2 working days after requesting. Many pharmacies also offer a prescription ordering and collection service.

CHAPERONE SERVICE

Some patients find that having another person in the room when intimate examinations are undertaken is helpful, if you would like a chaperone, please feel free to say so: it rarely creates difficulties, and there would be no question of your doctor being offended.

NHS WALK IN CENTRE - Tel 0115 8440212

London Road (next to the BBC) or Platform One near the train station provide a nurse-led drop-in service offering health advice, information and treatment of minor ailments. It is open 365 days a year from 7am to 9pm.

LOCAL PHARMACIES

They can offer advice and treatment of minor ailments. Under the Pharmacy First Scheme some simple medications are available such as: antihistamines, paracetamol etc...

You should only attend A&E if you have had an accident or you genuinely feel that your health needs constitute a medical emergency. Pressures on A&E continue, please only use this service under these circumstances

WHO SHOULD I SEE FOR MY PROBLEM?

We operate as an integral team within the practice and in many cases the most suitable person to see within the Medical Centre is not the doctor.

Practice Nurses - Management of chronic diseases including heart disease, diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure, well man and woman checks, travel advice and immunisations, minor illness, routine tests such as smears, blood pressure checks, wound care, removal of sutures, dressings etc.

Health Visitors - Tel 0115 8833100 - Advice and monitoring of children under 5, advice re immunisations, feeding, behavior, etc.

Midwives - Tel 0115 8833100- all aspects of ante-natal care.

School Nurses - Advice and monitoring of school age children, bed wetting, immunisations, etc.

Chiropodist - Tel 0115 8833100- Foot care.

Dentists - your local dentist can deal with dental problems and also problems with the mouth and gums.

Social Services - 0300 131 0300 Patients and careers can refer themselves to social services for assessment and for the provision of extra care.
